


Other Mammal Species Found on Nest Box Checks 2008




118 sites in June monitored with 50 or more boxes, at 79 of the sites dormice were found and at 39 of the sites no dormice were found

133 sites in October monitored with 50 or more boxes, at 96 of the sites dormice were found and at 37 of the sites no dormice were found

2008 NDMP Records

- 210 sites monitored
- 1198 visits made
- 3986 dormice recorded
- 14575 nest boxes monitored
- 45 sites recorded no dormice
- 55 dead dormice found
- 1411 males recorded, 1317 females and 1258 sex unidentified
- 9 the largest number in a box, a female with 8 juveniles at Blackmoor Copse, Wiltshire
- 41.8g heaviest dormouse found a male in October at Ladys Wood & Viaduct Meadow, Devon
- Most number of dormice found on one visit, 58 in September at Bontuchel, Clwyd
- 772 of the dormice found were in torpor – Feb=1 Apr=43, May=203, Jun=247, Jul=41, Aug=33, Sept=25, Oct=171, Nov=8
- 1043 young recorded
- 5 average litter size
